On August 20, 2016, an incredible wife, mother, daughter and friend; Tatum Bowerman-Hummel left her earthly life after a 28 month battle with breast cancer. She positively impacted everyone who was fortunate to spend time with her. Tatum was committed to educating, advocating for, and empowering individuals who are battling breast and other cancers, and those close to them. She was also passionate about supporting research into treatment and the eventual cure of metastatic cancers. TatumUntied was established in 2016 and is a 501(c)(3) organization committed to continuing her passion to support those battling cancer and their families through education and advocacy, as well as working to improve and support research into treatment and the eventual cure of metastatic cancers.

Through our battle, Tatum and I supported several organizations, some of which we came to realize do not responsibly manage the donations they receive, nor the efforts of their volunteers and staff. We also came to the conclusion that, currently, in many ways, improved technology could and should, not only build awareness, but also provide much better tools for educating and supporting those battling cancers, as well as to collect and share data that may provide researchers much needed data, without the cost of lengthy trials. This data, if available, can also help patients identify appropriate clinical trials with a much smaller investment of the precious time they may have left with their loved ones. At TatumUntied, we want to ensure that your donated items and dollars, as well as the efforts of our volunteers, are used as efficiently and responsibly as possible. For that reason, we are committed to building an organization with the lowest overhead possible. We will be staffed, as much as possible, by volunteers, and will operate for as long as possible, without a physical "brick and mortar" office. It is our goal to utilize the power of technology, the internet, and social media to streamline our efforts in order to achieve the impact that we know is possible.

We don't want to do things like everyone else. In order to accomplish our goals, we need the support of individuals and organizations like yours.
